



Keen to be Green Year 1 Summer Term 2019



The Big Idea:

The storybook character Supertato has sent us a mission to think about our planet and environment. As he is so keen to be green, he will be giving the children a set of tasks to learn about how we can help our world to be a cleaner and greener place.

As Language Specialists we will read a variety of traditional stories, recipe books, poetry, explanation texts and non-fiction texts. **As writers** we will continue to develop our handwriting whilst we write sentences, speech bubbles, letters, stories, recipes, explanation and information texts and poems.

As Mathematicians Revise pairs to 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10; derive subtraction facts; understand a symbol being used for an unknown; use number facts to solve simple addition and subtraction word problems; Find and begin to know doubles to double 10; use knowledge of pairs of 10 to make pairs to 20; use number facts to solve word problems. Add three small numbers, spotting pairs to 10 and doubles; begin to count in 5s and 2s recognising multiples of 5 end in 5 and 0; estimate a number of objects within a range and count by grouping into 10s or 5s; Relate units of time weeks, days, hours; divide the days up into parts; read and write times to the hour; begin to have a notion of how long an hour is and how long a minute is; tell the time (o'clock and half past) on analogue and digital clocks. Tell the time to the half hour and quarter hour on analogue clocks and begin to read these times on digital clocks.

As Geographers

We will devise a simple map of the school grounds and use basic symbols in a key.
We will also use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study features of the local area and daily weather patterns.

As Historians

We will learn about a real life person from history, Dame Jane Goodall. We will explore why she is a well-known conservationist.

As Scientists

We will be naming and identifying common wild and garden plants.
We will participate in planting vegetables and learn what they need to grow.

Across the curriculum

As Design Technologists We will be investigating and exploring wheels and axels. We will create our own moving vehicles to help us understand how they work.

As Artists We will be creating sculptures out of rubbish to highlight how much of our waste would normally end up in landfills. These will be displayed around the school grounds.

As Computer Programmers We will explore how to use computers and technology safely. We will look at storing our work, keeping passwords and logins secure and discuss how to stay safe when using the internet.

As Athletes We will take part in team games and prepare for Sports Day.

As Musicians We will create sounds using percussion and sing songs.

As members of the community we will take part in a Marske's litter pick, explore how to be a good friend and build good relationships.
