As language specialists we will be looking at the story of 'Viking Boy' and learning all about the Viking way of life. We will become journalists and write our own eyewitness reports and newspaper articles. We will also be exploring and writing our own dilemma stories.

As technologists we will be looking at E-Safety and programming to get the children ready for the ever so changing technological world. We will become E-Safety superheroes to help keep everyone safe online.

As geographers we will be looking at the UK. We will become map readers and learn about the land that makes up our unique island nations.

As French speakers we will be using French-English dictionaries to help us translate key words in order to be able to read and respond to letters that we have received from a year 5 class in France. Later in the term, we will also be looking at time.
